### A LETTER FROM KENYA

I received this letter from Bishop David Kaiga Monoru from Kenya via e-mail this morning. Though I usually choose not to share private thank-you notes corporately, I want you to understand what difference our congregation is making in the world. This is in response to my visit to Maua, Kenya, in early May. During that visit I preached and taught at an annual conference meeting and dedicated the school West Market has built at Ithata.

Dear Dave,

*Christian greetings to you, to your family and to the whole West Market Street Church from the Nyambene Synod of the Methodist Church in Kenya.*

*Your visit with us was such a great blessing to the Kenyan church. Your coming and preaching were highly appreciated. Words may not suffice to explain our joy and appreciation. How can we express the love you displayed and expressed where you went? God knows how grateful we are after your visit. It was God's plan to have you with us at this particular time.*

*Your sharing transformed the lives of many. One of the former Bishops was sharing with me about how positively you changed the way he looked at Christian life amid challenges, when you talked about Paul in prison and the*

*opportunity of sharing the gospel while in chains.*

*Kindly pass our appreciation and thanks to your church and to your wife and children for allowing you to come even when your dad was undergoing the brain operation. You made a lasting impact.*

*Thank you for accepting to support Ithata Project where the two classrooms have already been built. Amazingly there are already 200 students registered for that school. God is at work. As you said in your sharing, we are determined to claim that area for Jesus.*

*At Ithata, we look forward to having a big education institution; and to sink a borehole to provide water which is a scarce commodity in that area, an area where there is not a single stream.*

*I will furnish you with a detailed report after we have the hydrological survey done and all other estimates for classrooms and the evangelist. My wife Jane and children pass their love and greetings.*

*Thank you for your coming and all that you did towards the promotion of God's Kingdom in this corner of the world. Our prayers are with you.*

*Pass our love and appreciation to all of our brothers and sisters at West Market.*

The Art Committee is pleased to put on display in the Gathering Space a piece of art that we have had in our collection but needed to be refurbished. It is called *Departure from Our Lord's Supper* by Wilhelm August Theodor Steinhausen, a German painter, draughtsman, graphic artist and illustrator. He was born in Sorau, Germany, in 1846 and died in Frankfurt in 1924. He studied in Berlin and in Italy but settled in Frankfurt. Steinhausen was known for religious wall paintings, portraits and landscapes. His most well-known painting is a portrait of himself with his wife. Many of his works are in a museum, "Steinhausen Haus" in his former home in Frankfurt.

The refurbishment has made this piece come alive and we hope you enjoy its beauty and are moved by the significance of that event.
