Registrations can be sent beginning May 1st, and the registration deadline is June 21, 2010.

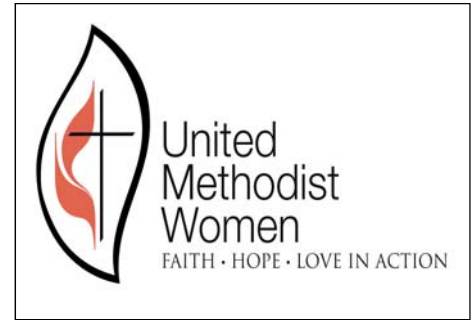
