**Did you know...**that almost 700 United Methodist Women arrived one day early for Assembly 2010, and spent an entire day serving in mission in agencies and communities all over St. Louis? It was called an Ubuntu Day of Service.



We think of ourselves far too frequently as just individuals, separated from one another, whereas you are connected and what you do affects the whole world. When you do well, it spreads out; it is for the whole of humanity.”

**Ubuntu** is an African word. Archbishop Desmond Tutu describes the meaning like this:

“One of the sayings in our country is Ubuntu - the essence of being human. Ubuntu speaks particularly about the fact that you can't exist as a human being in isolation. It speaks about our interconnectedness. You can't be human all by yourself, and when you have this quality - Ubuntu - you are known for your generosity.
